### **Soul Soup Opportunities**

We invite you to consider two opportunities to support the Soul Soup ministry. The first is to be the team lead the 4th Thursday each month, which means setting up and coordinating the meal. The second is to pick up bread, which is donated by Panera once each month on the fourth Wednesday. Panera is located out on Queensgate in Richland. Pick up is about 8:45 pm and is usually 4 to 5 boxes of bread and pastries. These are delivered to the church where they are sorted and used at Soul Soup dinner. Any left overs (and there are usually plenty) are taken to the Mission and/or Dayspring Ministries by another team member.

Here is what is needed starting in December:

1. Someone to lead the team on the 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday (Dec. 27) and prepare the meal. This would be a one-time deal, unless you are inclined to do so on a regular basis.
2. On a longer-term basis, someone to lead the team on the 4th Thursday each month. This would involve contacting the volunteers and arranging the dinner.
3. Someone to do the Panera pick up on the 4th Wednesday each month.
